Qualifying Life Events	Definition	Application Submission
 <p>Loss of Minimum Essential Coverage</p>	<p>Loss of Minimum Essential Coverage on another health plan as a result of death, loss of dependent status (you turned 26) or because the health plan stopped offering benefits</p>	<p>Within 60 days of coverage loss</p>
 <p>Marital status change</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Marriage • Divorce (if losing coverage) 	<p>Within 60 days of event</p>
 <p>New addition</p>	<p>Birth, adoption, placement for adoption or provisional custody</p>	<p>Within 60 days of event, which begins the date of the marriage, birth, adoption, legal placement for adoption or mandate granting legal or provisional custody of a child or grandchild</p>
 <p>Losing coverage at work</p>	<p>If you lose your employer coverage or employer contributions, or coverage no longer meets affordability requirements of federal law</p>	<p>Within 60 days after other coverage ends (or after employer stops contributing toward other coverage)</p>
 <p>Moving</p>	<p>Permanent move to an area not served by your current health plan</p>	<p>Within 60 days of event</p>
 <p>Pre-ACA plan doesn't meet Qualified Health Plan requirements</p>	<p>Your existing plan does not meet minimum Qualified Health Plan requirements</p>	<p>Within 60 days of event</p>
 <p>COBRA expiration</p>	<p>If COBRA was elected and has expired</p>	<p>Within 60 days of event</p>
